This guide describes a quick and easy way to get up and running with the product.

Product overview

IBM[®] Platform LSF[®] (LSF) is a powerful workload management platform for demanding, distributed HPC environments. It provides a comprehensive set of intelligent, policy-driven scheduling features that enable you to utilize all of your compute infrastructure resources and ensure optimal application performance.

Step 1: Access the software and documentation packages



Download the LSF installer package, product distribution packages, product entitlement packages, and documentation packages from IBM Passport Advantage:

2 Step 2: Access the documentation

Find LSF documentation on the IBM Knowledge Center (http://www.ibm.com/support/knowledgecenter/SSETD4). You can search all the content in IBM Knowledge Center, search within a product, or restrict your search to one version of a product. Sign in with your IBM ID to take full advantage of the personalization features available in IBM Knowledge Center. Create and print custom collections of documents you use regularly, and communicate with colleagues and IBM by adding comments to topics.
